1. Theodore Booth's water right interests in the SRBA:  
I own and occupy a single residence in Twin Falls County. The domestic water is supplied by a domestic well. I have filed a claim in the SRBA for a domestic water right, claim number 47-17214. In addition, lawn and garden irrigation water is supplied by a homeowners association, which holds shares in the Twin Falls Canal Company.
2. SRBA water right interests of my family within the third degree of consanguinity or affinity:  
I am not aware that I have any relatives within the third degree of consanguinity or affinity that claim water rights in Idaho.
