**STIPULATED MOTION AND  
SUPPORTING POINTS FOR  
EXTENSION OF TIME TO LODGE  
THE AGENCY RECORD**

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION FOR  
TRANSFER NO. 85719 IN THE NAME OF  
VEOLIA WATER IDAHO, INC.

The parties, through their undersigned attorneys of record, in accordance with I.R.C.P. 84(f)(3), 84(o), and 2.5 and the Procedural Order Governing Judicial Review of Final Order of Director of Idaho Department of Water Resources issued by the Court in this matter on March 20, 2023, hereby stipulate and jointly move

the Court for an extension of time to lodge the agency record with the agency and lodge the settled agency record with the Court.

For the following reasons, there is good cause to grant the stipulated request:

1. Pursuant to this Court's Procedural Order, the record in this matter is due to be lodged with the agency on or before April 3, 2023.

2. Due to staff workload, the Department estimates it needs an additional three weeks to lodge the record with the agency.

3. Pursuant to this Court's Procedural Order, the settled agency record in this matter is due to be lodged with the Court on or before May 1, 2023.

4. If the requested three-week extension is granted to lodge the record with the agency, then the settled agency record will be due to be lodged with the Court only 7 days later.

5. Pursuant to this Court's Procedural Order and I.R.C.P. 84(j)(1)(C), the parties are allowed 14 days from the date of mailing or delivery of the notice of lodging the record with the agency in which to file any objections to the record.

6. If the requested three-week extension is granted to lodge the agency record with the agency, then the Department estimates that it will need an additional two weeks to lodge the settled agency record with the Court. The Department estimates that two additional weeks will provide enough time to allow the parties to file any objections to the agency record and for the Department to review and respond to any objections.

Accordingly, the parties in this matter respectfully request an order from the Court (1) extending the time to lodge the record with the agency to April 24, 2023, and (2) extending the time to lodge the settled agency record with the Court to May 15, 2023.
