Petitioner, Veolia Water Idaho, Inc. ("Veolia"), and Respondent, the Idaho Department of Water Resources ("Department"), by and through their undersigned attorneys of record, pursuant to I.R.C.P. 84(r) and I.A.R. 33, hereby stipulate for the dismissal of the above-captioned appeal.

On March 16, 2023, Veolia commenced this action by filing a *Petition for Judicial Review*. On March 27, 2023, Veolia commenced another court action by filing a *Motion to Set*

Aside Final Unified Decree and to Correct or Amend the Partial Decree for Water Right No. 63-9245, In re SRBA, Case No. 39576, Subcase No. 63-9245, with the District Court of the Fifth Judicial District of the State of Idaho, in and for the County of Twin Falls (the "SRBA Matter"). Both filings sought an order from the Court to modify the same condition included in the partial

Veolia and the Department agreed it was not necessary to have the two cases moving forward at the same time, so to promote judicial efficiency and the economic interest of the parties, the parties filed a *Stipulated Motion and Supporting Points to Suspend Appeal* in this case on April 24, 2023. On April 25, 2023, this Court issued an *Order Granting Stipulated Motion to Suspend Appeal*.

In the SRBA Matter, the Twin Falls County District Court has since addressed the common issue raised. Therefore, Veolia no longer seeks to pursue its petition and the parties agree to an order dismissing the subject appeal.

The parties acknowledge and agree that each party shall bear its own costs and attorneys' fees incurred in or arising out of the above-captioned matter.
