I. FINDINGS OF FACT

A claim was filed for this water right pursuant to I.C. § 42-1409. The Director of the State of Idaho Department of Water Resources examined the water system for this reporting area. A Director's Report and Amended Director's Report were filed containing recommendations for the elements of this water right.

Objections were filed by the United States of America as trustee, and the Nez Perce Tribe joined in the Objections. Subsequently, the United States filed its United States Motion to Withdraw Objection. The Nez Perce Tribe joined in the Motion to Withdraw. The Court granted the Withdrawal of Objections. Order Dismissing Objection (August 11, 2025)

There are no unresolved *Objections* remaining in this subcase. Therefore, this water right will be recommended consistent with the *Amended Director's Report*.

II. CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Therefore, based on the file and record herein, IT IS RECOMMENDED that this water right be decreed with the elements set forth in the attached *Special Master's Recommendation for Partial Decree*.






