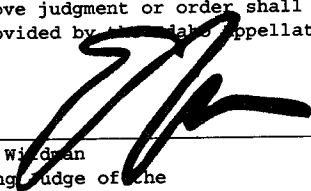
Right Nos. 97-2019 and 97-7043 are limited to the irrigation of a combined total of 30 acres in a single irrigation season.
