Rights 97-7276 and 97-7279 authorize a total annual storage volume of 6.1 acre-feet to be used for the initial filling of the pond, for the replacement of losses caused by evaporation, and for the storage of water for irrigation purposes. The pond established by the storage of water under this right shall not exceed a total capacity of 1.9 acre-feet or a total surface area of 0.19 acres. Right Nos. 97-7276 and 97-7279 are limited to a total combined diversion rate of 0.07 cfs and to a total combined annual diversion volume of 12.4 AF.

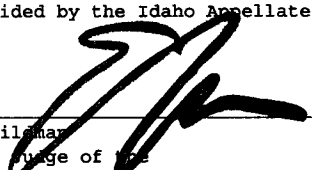
Right Nos. 97-7276 and 97-7279 are limited to the irrigation of a combined total of 2.9 acres in a single irrigation season.
