POINT OF DIVERSION: T59N R04W S02 LOT 4 (NWNW) Within Bonner County

The approach velocity at the point of diversion shall not exceed 0.5 feet per second.

A fish screen of 0.25 inch or smaller mesh shall be installed and maintained at the point of diversion.

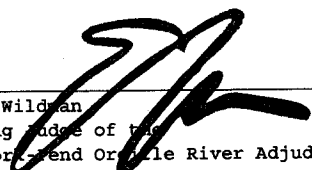
