A fish screen of 1/4 inch or smaller mesh shall be installed and
maintained at the point of diversion.
This right does not grant any right-of-way or easement across
the land of another.

The term of this water right license shall extend to December
31, 2039. Prior to the expiration of the term, the Director may
issue an order canceling all or any part of the use authorized
herein, may establish a new term, or may revise, delete, or add
conditions under which the water right license may be exercised.
The order shall take effect on the date the current term
expires. If the Director does not issue such an order, the term

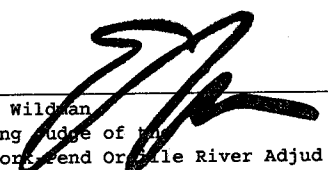

shall automatically extend to a length equal to the project's prior term and any prior conditions on the water right license shall remain in effect.

THIS PARTIAL DECREE IS SUBJECT TO SUCH GENERAL PROVISIONS NECESSARY FOR THE DEFINITION OF THE RIGHTS OR FOR THE EFFICIENT ADMINISTRATION OF THE WATER RIGHTS AS MAY BE ULTIMATELY DETERMINED BY THE COURT AT A POINT IN TIME NO LATER THAN THE ENTRY OF A FINAL UNIFIED DECREE. I.C. SECTION 42-1412(6).
