Right 97-7520 authorizes a total annual storage volume of 6.4 acre-feet, 5.1 acre-feet to be used for the initial filling or carryover storage of the pond and 1.3 acre-feet for the replacement of losses caused by evaporation. Rights 97-7325 and 97-7520 when combined shall not exceed a total annual maximum diversion volume of 6.4 af at the field headgate, for wildlife and fire protection storage. The pond established by the storage of water under this right shall not exceed a total capacity of 5.1 acre-feet or a total surface area of 1.6 acres.

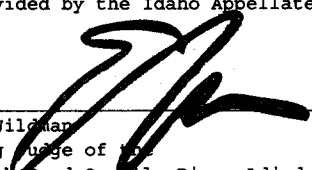
